



Buffalo Linen Stitch Cowl

Materials:

The Buffalo Wool Company - Splash of Color Buffalo Skies bison/wool mini-skeins (9 skeins of 20 yards) – about 135 yards used

US 5 – 3.75 mm circular needles

Darning needle

Stitch marker

Gauge: 18 stitches x 44 rows = 4 in

Cast on 120 stitches. Place marker at the beginning of the round.

Row 1: K1, (slip 1 with yarn in front, K1) repeat until end of the round.

Row 2: K1, (K1, slip 1 with yarn in front) repeat until end of the round.

This pattern will create a visible seam with the starting K1 of each row. I found it easier to use this seam to anchor each new color strand when changing colors. To remove this seam from the pattern, cast on an odd number of stitches (119 or 121) and ignore the first K1 of each row.

To get the color pattern shown in the photograph, knit 2 rounds in the following color order for 3 repeats:

1. Dark Grey
2. Light Green
3. Brown
4. Pink
5. Purple
6. Light Grey
7. Blue
8. Red
9. Dark Green
