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## **Sideways Triangle Shawl**

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**This pattern can be used with any flat bed knitting machine.**

**This pattern assumes that the knitter has basic knowledge of the flat bed knitting machine being used.** This assumption includes casting on with an e-wrap cast on, knitting with the carriage, decreasing, increasing with or without eyelets, and binding off. This pattern also assumes that the knitter will have previously determined the carriage dial settings and tension rod settings for the weight of yarn that will be used.

**This pattern starts with the carriage on the right hand side of the bed.** All odd number rows will move the carriage from right to left. All even number rows will move the carriage from left to right. If you want to start your shawl with the carriage on the left hand side of the bed, you will need to reverse any directional instructions.

## **Pattern:**

**Right edge** - edge of the work nearest your right hand

**Left edge** - edge of the work nearest your left hand

### **Waste Yarn:**

Cast on 3 needles at the right hand side of the bed and knit several rows on waste yarn to hang weights

### **Cast On:**

Cast on 3 stitches with an e-wrap cast on  
Start with carriage on right side - Knit 2 rows

### **Set Up Rows:**

Row 3 - Move left edge 2 sts to the left to inc without eyelet, then knit row

Row 4 - Knit row

Row 5 - Move left edge 2 sts to the left to inc without eyelet, then knit row

Row 6 - Knit row

Row 7 - Move left edge 2 sts to the left to inc without eyelet, then knit row

Row 8 - Knit row

### **First Half:**

Row 9 - Move left edge 2 sts to the left to inc with eyelet, move the 3rd st from the right edge to the left for eyelet, then knit row

Row 10 - Knit row

Repeat Rows 9 & 10 to the middle of the shawl. This can be either half of the yarn or until all needles are used.

### **Second Half:**

Row A - Move left edge 2 sts right to dec 1, move 1 st right of the dec to the right to create eyelet, move the 3rd st from the right edge to the left for eyelet, then knit row

Row B - Knit row

Repeat Rows A & B until 7 sts remain.

### **Finishing Rows:**

Row C - Move left edge 2 sts to the right to dec 1, move 1 st right of the dec to the right to create eyelet, then knit row

Row D - Knit row

Row E - Move left edge 2 sts to the right to dec 1, then knit

Row F - Knit row

Repeat Rows E & F until 3 stitches remain.

Pull tail through last 3 sts to finish off the shawl.
